## SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED MOTION

Subject: Major Championship Selection

Intent: Define the WCA Major Championship selection process

## **Motion**

Major Championship host cities are selected via a bidding procedure that is initiated by the WCA Board and led by the WCA Major Championship Team.

- 1. Major Championship events include WCA Continental Championships and the WCA World Championships.
  - 1.1 WCA Continental Championships shall be held in even numbered years.
  - 1.2 The WCA World Championship shall be held in odd numbered years.
- 2. At the start of the bidding procedure the WCA Major Championship Team will announce which Championships are available for bidding, along with a deadline for applicants to submit bid documents and topics which bid documents must address.
  - 2.1 The WCA Major Championship Team may choose to hold an expression of interest period prior to the formal bidding procedure.
- 3. Applications must be made by a WCA Regional Organization.
  - 3.1 Exception: at the discretion of the WCA Financial Committee and the WCA Board, if the host city is located in a region without a WCA Regional Organization, the application may be made by a registered entity which is not a WCA Regional Organization.
- 4. Once applications are closed the WCA Board will appoint a selection committee based on the recommendation of the WCA Major Championship Team.
  - 4.1 The selection committee must have at least 5 members.
  - 4.2 The selection committee must have at least: one Director, one representative from the WCA Major Championship Team, and one volunteer from WCA Leaders and Senior Delegates.
  - 4.3 Members of the selection committee must not be involved in an application for the Major Championship.
- 5. Once a selection committee is formed they will determine which applicants will proceed to an interview.
  - 5.1 This determination may be informed by information gathered through the expression of interest period (if held), the bid document, and other factors at the discretion of the selection committee.
  - 5.2 The selection committee will conduct interviews with application teams to gain a better understanding of the proposed event.
- 6. Once the selection committee has conducted interviews with the application teams they will vote to select a host city.
- 7. In the case that no applications are selected the WCA Board may initiate another application period at a later date.
